The challenge at this stage is how to assess student work when everything is open and available, and students can communicate with each other when being tested. .We need new ways of assessing our students in an environment and make sure they have the chance to reflect, argue and demonstrate their Competence alone and with the help of others.

Sandvika school was new in 2006, it has since the beginning been a 1:1 school. All its students have laptops and wireless connection is available in the whole building. In 2015 it was awarded the most innovative school in Norway. Ann was a member of the 2013 Horizon Norway Advisory Board, 2014 Scandinavian Horizon board, and [2014 Horizon Report Europe Advisory Board](#). In 2012 she wrote the book “[Connected Learners: A Step-by-Step Guide to Creating a Global Classroom](#)” with 27 high school students. She spoke at Bett in London 2014 and was recognized by BBC News Technology and BBC Click. The result was an article on [BBC News](#) and a team of reporters from BBC Click and BBC school report visited Sandvika school, this was aired on BBC world. She was portrayed in the Italian newspaper Corriere Della Sera in 2014. Ann has written a book for teachers in Norway published by CappelenDamm in 2015, and a second edition of the book in 2019. She is currently working on translating the book “**Best practiced in the digital classroom**” to English.
